Bike Inn Theory and Foundation Training & Qualification incorporation IMI Bicycle Mechanics Level 2

Over the last year we have created our primary teaching structure of blended learning. The format we offer for our Theory and Foundation course is 4-week virtual learning. Our virtual course is a combination of videos, written theory, quizzes and basic practical’s at home. We have interactive online meetings on a week night and a master class on Saturday mornings (recorded if you can’t attend).

Once you have completed your Theory and Foundation virtual course you can attend our Intensive Practical Qualification week onsite. During this week we will ensure you complete any practice you have not been able to master at home e.g. Wheel building and hydraulics.

The skills and knowledge you gain on this course should be sufficient to start your own repair business, get work at a bike shop or in event support. We take pride in supporting all of our students long after they have been with us.

Want to progress on your Theory and Foundation Qualification(incorporating IMI L2)?

Our Professional course is the next step, if you are a Bike Inn Graduate (have complete our Theory and Foundation course) you need to complete our Professional virtual course (4 weeks) and Professional course onsite (1 week).

- Theory & Foundation Part 1 : Modules 1-4 | 4 weeks online learning
- Wheel Building | 2 days practical on-site training in Cumbria
- Theory & Foundation Part 2 : Modules 5-8 | 4 weeks online learning
- Intensive Professional Qualification | 1 week training and assessment in Cumbria
